TIPS to get the most out of your Chlorhexidine Mouthwash



Brush your teeth first

Start by thoroughly brushing and flossing your teeth. Mechanically removing plaque from your teeth will reduce potential side effects when using Chlorhexidine mouthwashes.

We always recommend using a soft brush with a high number of densely packed bristles.

The Curaprox CS5460 Ultra Soft toothbrush is a soft, dense bristled brush.

SLS free toothpaste

Always check your toothpaste's ingredients to avoid a toothpaste containing Sodium Lauryl Sulphate (SLS) whilst using a Chlorhexidine mouthwash. SLS can negate the benefits of Chlorhexidine. If you are brushing with toothpaste containing SLS, wait at least 1 hour before using a Chlorhexidine mouthwash. Sodium Lauryl Sulphate is a foam forming agent used in some toothpaste.

How much mouthwash to use

Use the dedicated measuring cup included with all Perio Plus+ mouthwash products when rinsing. Use only as the product instructs you to use or as recommended by your Dental Professional.



Ready, set, rinse

Empty the cup into your mouth and swish it around. Don't swallow it. Mouthwash is not meant to be ingested. Rinse and gargle for 60 seconds or as instructed by your Dental Professional. Enjoy the refreshing citrus flavour of Curaprox Perio Plus+ with no taste alteration.

SAFE TO USE: Perio Plus+ does not contain alcohol.



Spit it out

Spit the mouthwash out into the basin. Repeat morning and evening or as instructed by your Dental Professional.



During treatment, avoid consuming tobacco and foods that can discolour natural teeth and dental restorations – including coffee, red wine, juices, green and black tea, berries, cherries, saffron, and curry. In combination with mechanical cleaning, this can minimise the risk of discolouration.

Consumers should always use Chlorhexidine mouthwashes as prescribed by their Dental Professional and within the time guidelines provided for each strength in the range. Over-use of a Chlorhexidine mouthwash may result in discolouration of the teeth and gums. If you do experience tooth discolouration when using Chlorhexidine products don't worry, it is not permanent and can be removed by a professional dental cleaning.
